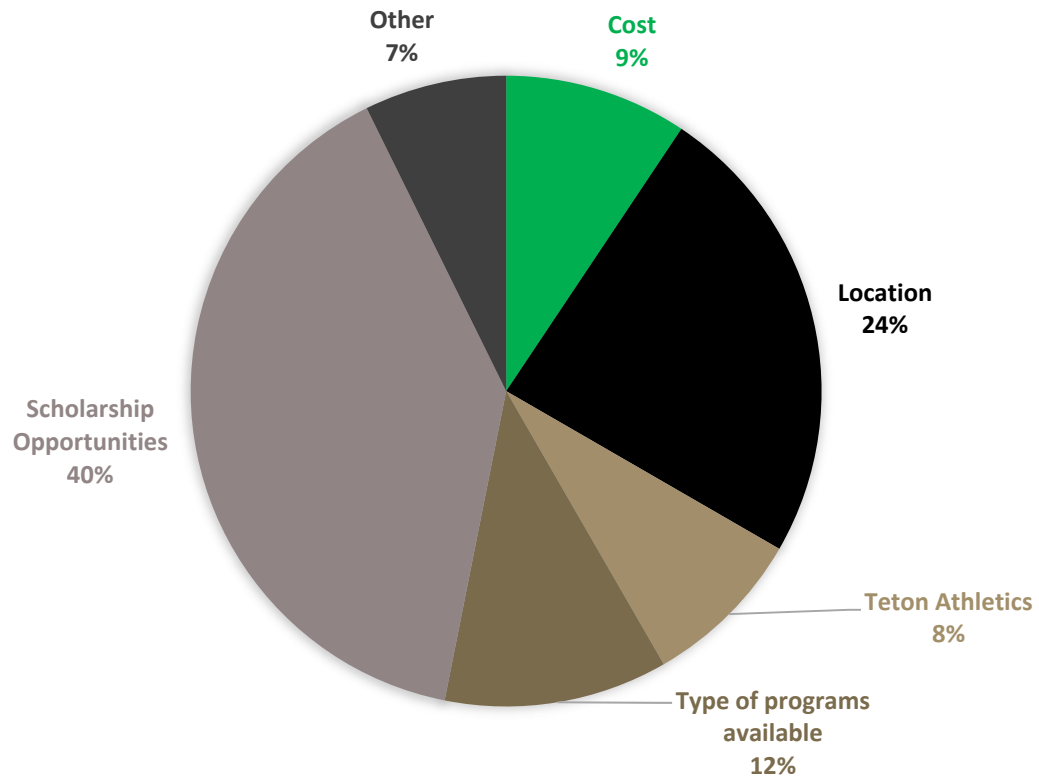

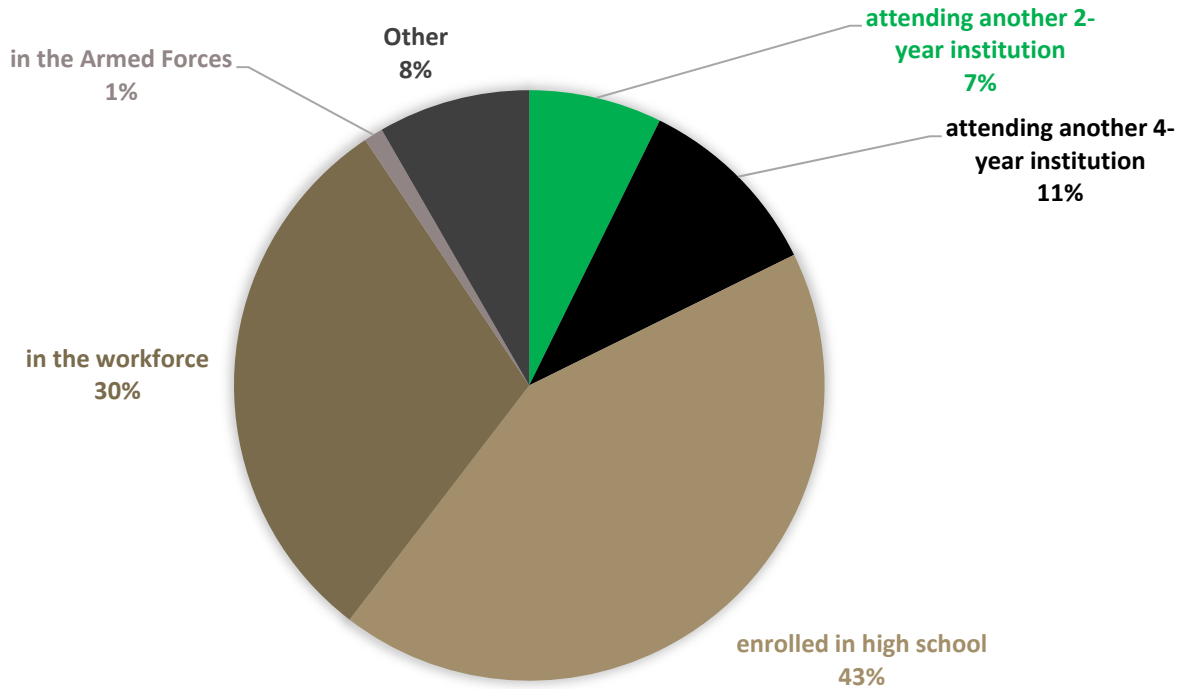

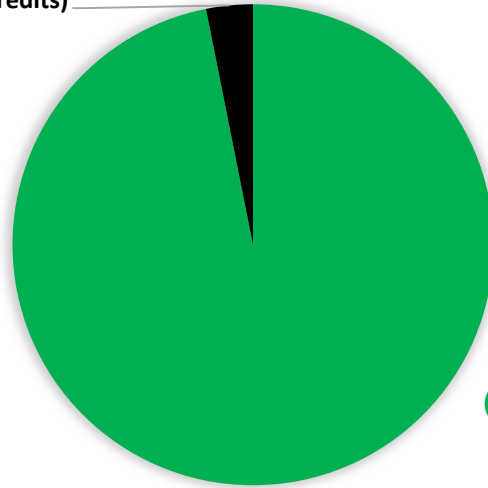


### 2017: STATUS PRIOR TO ENROLLING AT WSC

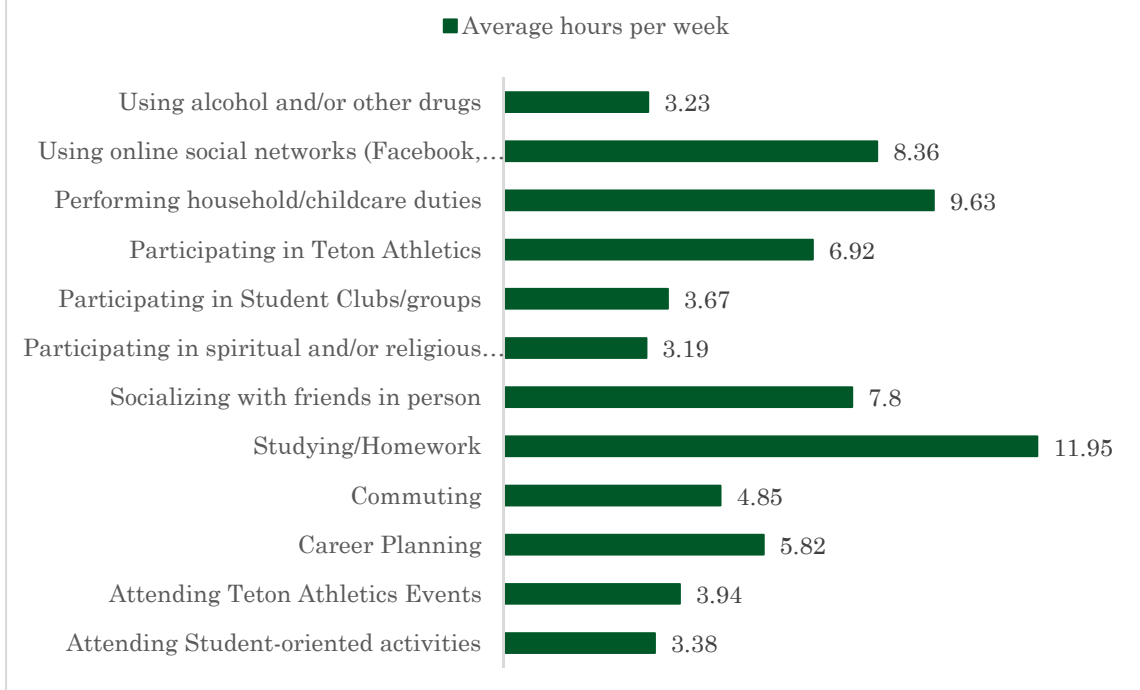

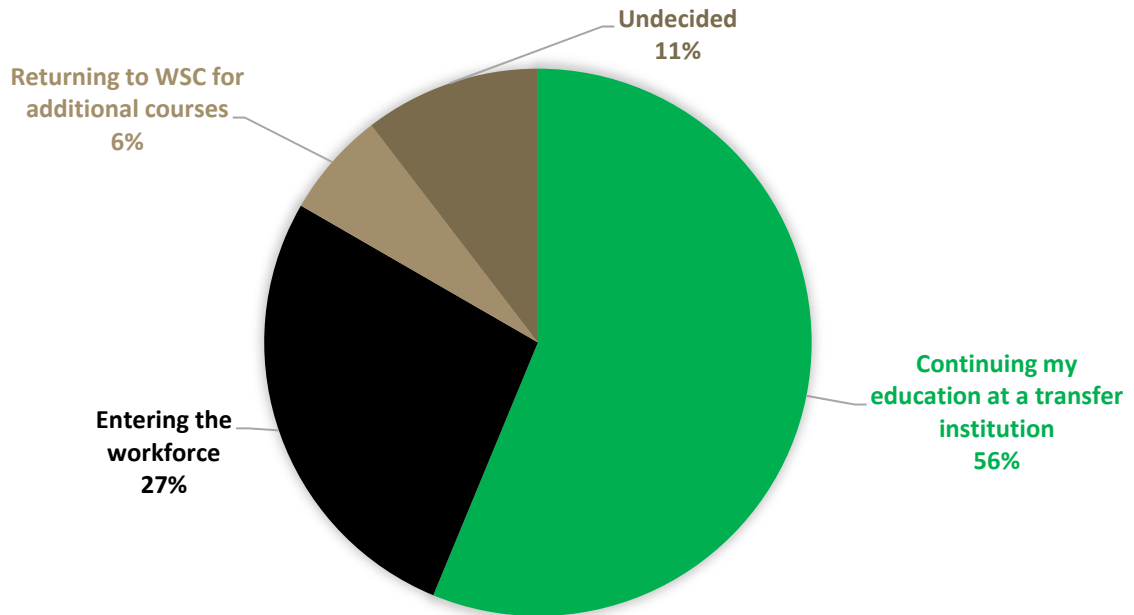

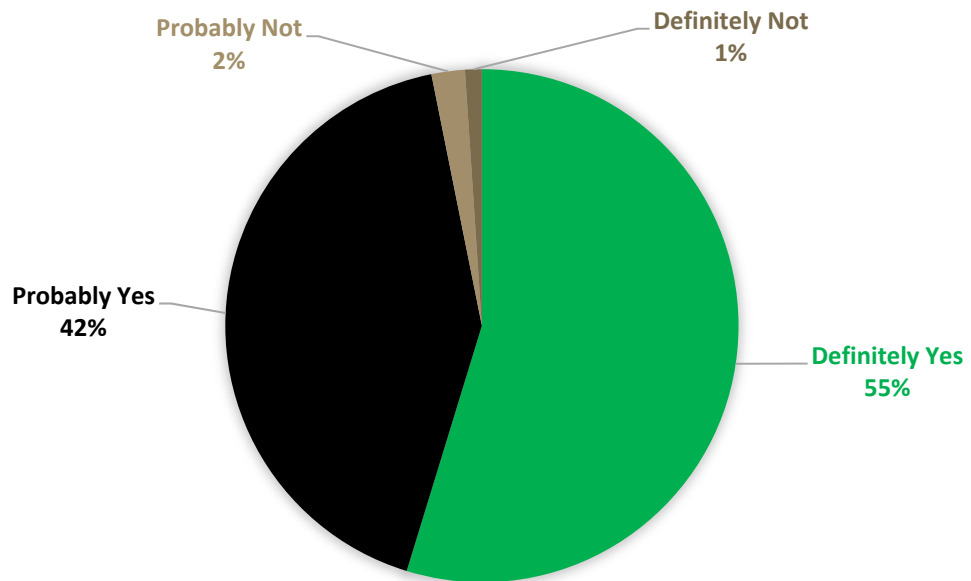
### 2017: Average hours spent per week on activities
